

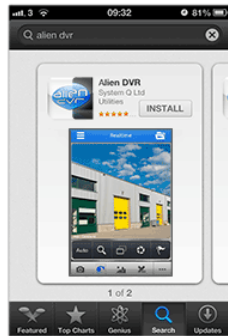

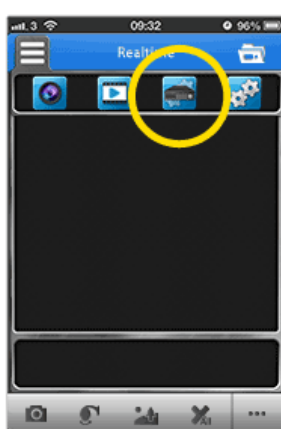
Alien Hero Smartphone App Instructions.

Iphone





- 1** Download the latest alien DVR app from the app store, simply search for 'alien DVR' and install. (On first opening the app you will get a brief guide covering the main features and gestures.)



- 2** Click the menu option and select the Device Management icon from the tab bar.

- 3** Click the + to add a new device. Enter the following details and tap the the save icon when done.


Name: (choose device name)

Port: (device port number, default 8000)



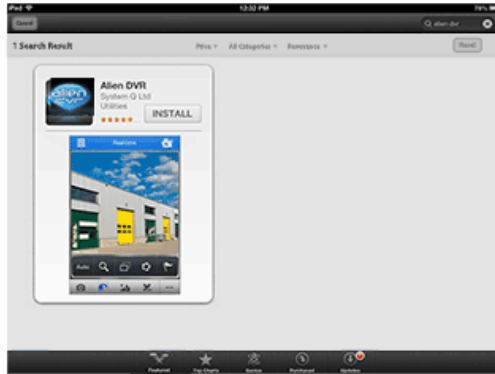

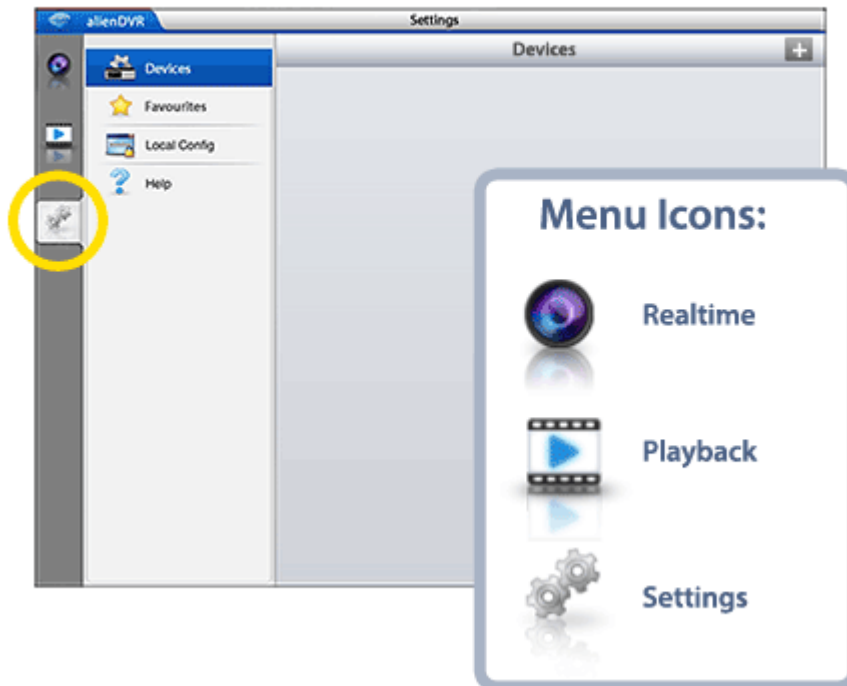


Ipad

- 2 **In the app tap the 'Settings' icon on the left and make sure you're in the 'Devices' sub-menu.**

Port: (device port number, default 8000)

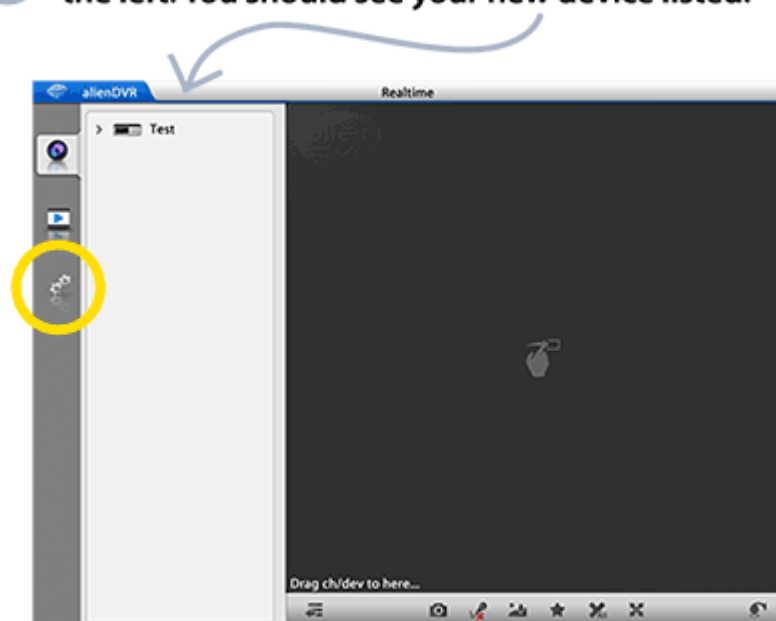
Username: (device username, default 'admin')

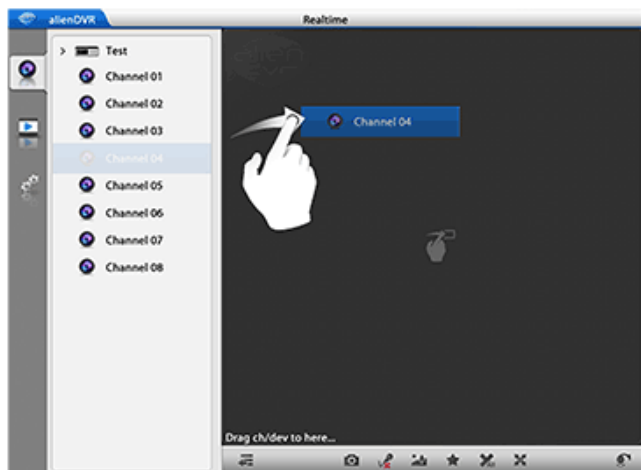

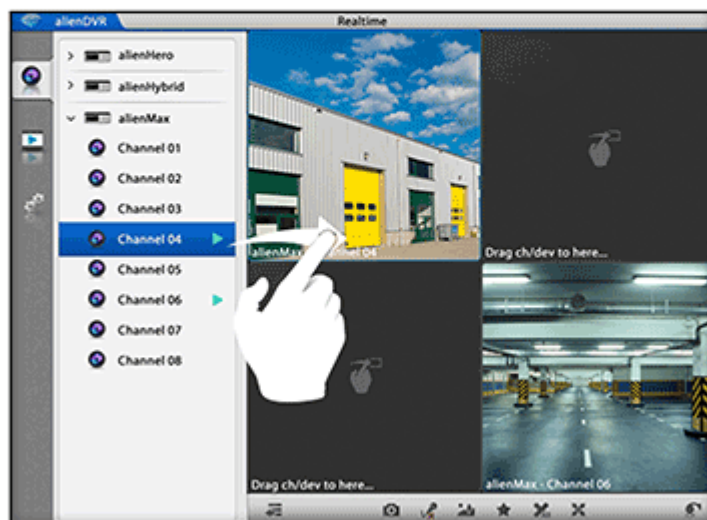
After adding your device tap the 'Realtime' icon on the left. You should see your new device listed.




- 5** To start your live viewing simply drag a camera node onto the main window or, alternatively, you can drag the device icon itself to start all cameras.

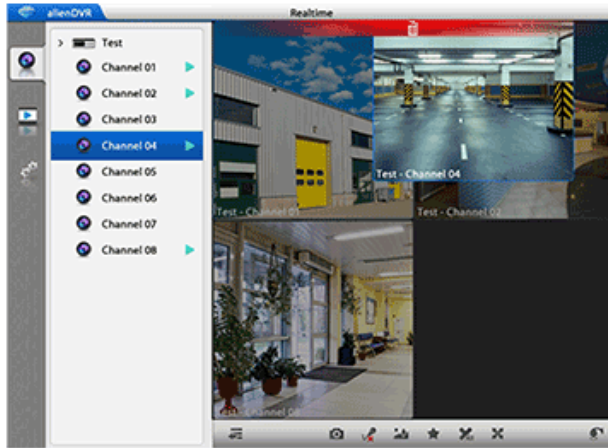


- 6** You can continue dragging cameras to create your desired view set up.
(You can then save this setup for easy opening by tapping the star and adding to favourite views.)



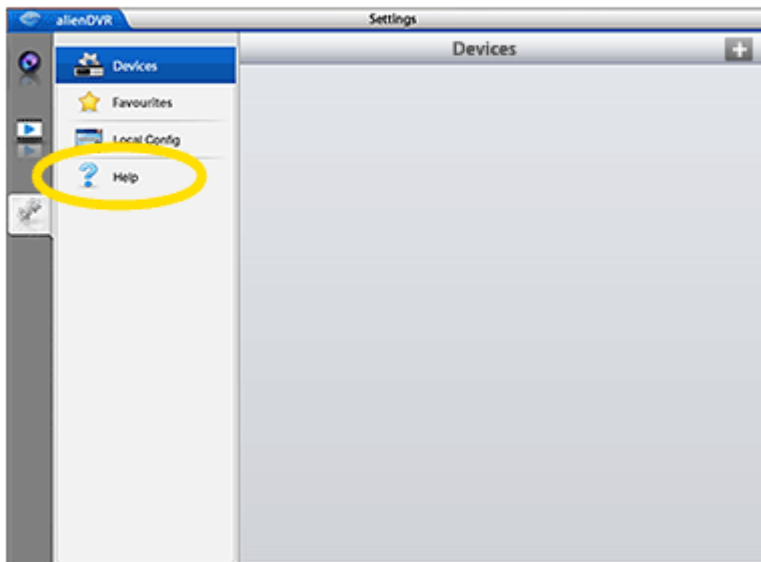

To stop realtime playing you can either click the 'Stop All' icon:  or you can drag individual cameras to the top of the screen and drop into the red highlighted bin.

- 1 **Navigate to www.aliendvr.com on your Android device and click the 'Mobile Clients' tab. Scroll down and download the latest Android client software.**

- 2 **Install the app and open. You will be prompted to make a login account to ensure secure access.** (Please note you will have to have 3rd party app installation enabled on your device. This can be found as an option under Application/Security Settings and reads: 'Allow installation of non-market applications'.)
